## BYLAW 7 – 2013

### **A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A SPACE DESIGNATED FOR PEOPLE WITH A DISABILITY.**

The Council of the Village of Middle Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw will be known as the Disability Parking Bylaw.
2. For the Purpose of this bylaw the word:
  - a) Permit means a parking permit issued by the Saskatchewan Abilities Council to a person with a disability;
  - b) Vehicle means a vehicle, or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to by *The Traffic Safety Act*;
  - c) Council means the Council of the Village of Middle Lake; and
  - d) Municipality means the Village of Middle Lake.
3. No person shall stop or park a motor vehicle in a designated parking space for people with disabilities without an authorized permit suspended from the rearview mirror and visible through the front windshield of the vehicle.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 3 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1000.00 in the case of an individual, or \$5000.00 in the case of a corporation.
