VILLAGE OF MIDDLE

BYLAW 7 - 2013

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A SPACE DESIGNATED FOR PEOPLE WITH A DISABILITY.

The Council of the Village of Middle Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw will be known as the Disability Parking Bylaw.
- 2. For the Purpose of this bylaw the word:
 - a) Permit means a parking permit issued by the Saskachewan Abilities Council to a person with a disability;
 - b) Vehicle means a vehicle, or semi-trailer or a motor vehicle as ascribed to by *The Traffic Safety Act;*
 - c) Council means the Council of the Village of Middle Lake; and
 - d) Municipality means the Village of Middle Lake.
- 3. No person shall stop or park a motor vehicle in a designated parking space for people with disabilities without an authorized permit suspended from the rearview mirror and visible through the front windshield of the vehicle.
- 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 3 is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1000.00 in the case of an individual, or \$5000.00 in the case of a corporation.
